QHSE Update

It has been a busy year at Knight Oil Tools in the areas of Quality, Health, Safety and the Environment (QHSE). According to Mike Pothier, Chief Safety and Compliance Officer, several new initiatives are currently underway and several industry recertification programs are culminating in the fourth quarter of the year.

In April, Knight Manufacturing's Rayne, LA fabrication facility successfully retained its ISO 9001: 2008 Quality Management System certification. ISO (International Organization for Standardization) is an independent organization comprised of 165 member countries. ISO develops standards based on opinions of its technical committees to ensure products and services provide safety, reliability, quality and efficiency worldwide.

QHSE management is also developing revisions for the implementation of the API Q1 Quality Management System for Knight Manufacturing. The official launch of the system is scheduled for late this month.

Tri*Drill Services is currently in the process of recertification for its Fearnley Proctor NS-1™ and NS-2™ Certifications for its Broussard, LA facility. The NS-1 Certification is for the unit's hardbanding application facility and the NS-2 Certification is for the drill pipe inspection facility. The certification programs provide companies with an industry-recognized approval program that supplements the requirement of the American Petroleum Institute (API) standards for superior quality management and performance.

Knight Oil Tools has also announced in July, the implementation of a formal QHSE Management System that is designed to meet international QHSE requirements and improve overall the company's worldwide QHSE performance. To date, eight sessions of the QHSE Leadership Training program have been held at various locations to explain the system and its requirements.

According to Mark Knight, President and Chief Executive Officer, "These initiatives and certifications prove that Knight Oil Tools is committed to offering quality products and service while focused on the health and safety of our employees, customers and the environment."
